

## **CALL FOR SELECTION FOR UNIVERSITY STUDENTS**

### **8<sup>th</sup> OTIE INTERNATIONAL SUMMER SCHOOL ON TOURISM ECONOMICS**

**Gozo, Malta**

**a. a. 2018/2019**

The Observatory on Tourism for Islands Economy - OTIE - publishes a call for selection for university students, graduates and post graduates who want to increase their practical and theoretical knowledge and skills in tourism. In particular, OTIE proposes a highly professionalizing training activity that allows to get to know the tourism sector and apply its knowledge in a development plan for the territory to promote tourism in the islands.

The Summer School organized in collaboration with the University of Malta and the Gozo Chamber of Commerce, aims to provide the technical and scientific content now essential for the training of future professionals in the field of event promotion, destination marketing and tourism in the islands, providing a particular specialization on the subject in question.

The call refers to the summer course:

"Islands Events Management" (Gozo, 07/29/2019 - 03/08/2019), which will take place entirely in English and will involve international experts in the field of event tourism management, coming from the Universities of Bournemouth, Greenwich and Malta. The course foresees the realization of an operational project related to the organization of an event, which will be presented to the local authorities for the eventual implementation of the same.

## BENEFICIARIES

Can apply, within the established deadlines, students enrolled in a three-year degree course, master's degree, single-cycle degree, first or second level master's degree, doctorate and specialization, including Erasmus students. Candidates are required to have knowledge of English equivalent to level B1 of the Common European Framework of Reference.

**PARTICIPANTS: max. 20 for each course**

- Final project work.

A Commission composed by the Executive Staff of OTIE will evaluate the applications received based on the following criteria:

- curriculum vitae;
- motivational letter;
- knowledge of the English language.

The Commission will send a communication via e-mail regarding the result of the selection by the indicated date:

- 22 July – “Islands Events Management”

#### CERTIFICATION

The Observatory on Tourism for Islands Economy will issue a certificate relating to the training activity carried out by the candidate.

#### CONTRIBUTION OF PARTICIPATION

The number of places available is 20, the selected students will have to pay an initial contribution of 50 euros as an advance of the registration fee to cover the expenses of the Summer School.

- € 300 for registrations received no later than May 31st 2019 (Payment of € 50 by May 31st)
- € 350 for registrations received by the deadline of 26 July 2019 (Payment of € 50 by 20 July)
